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CLARIN in eight bullets

- **CLARIN** is the Common Language Resources and Technology Infrastructure
- **ESFRI** ERIC status since 2012, Landmark since 2016
- that provides easy and sustainable access for scholars in the **humanities and social sciences** and beyond
- to a distributed network of **digital language data** (in written, spoken, video or multimodal form)
- and **advanced tools** to discover, explore, exploit, annotate, analyse or combine them, wherever they are located
- through a **single sign-on** environment
- that serves as an ecosystem for **knowledge exchange**
- some services **integrated in EOSC** (member of European Open Science Cloud; [link](#))

- advanced tools - to discover, explore, exploit, annotate, analyse or combine data sets, *wherever they are located*



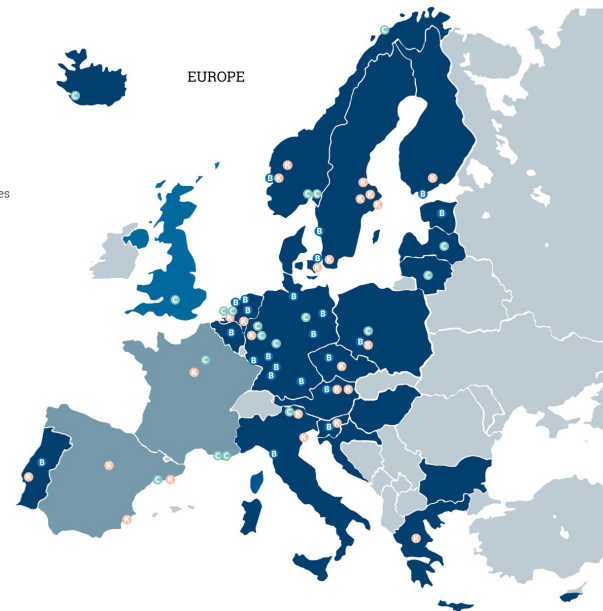

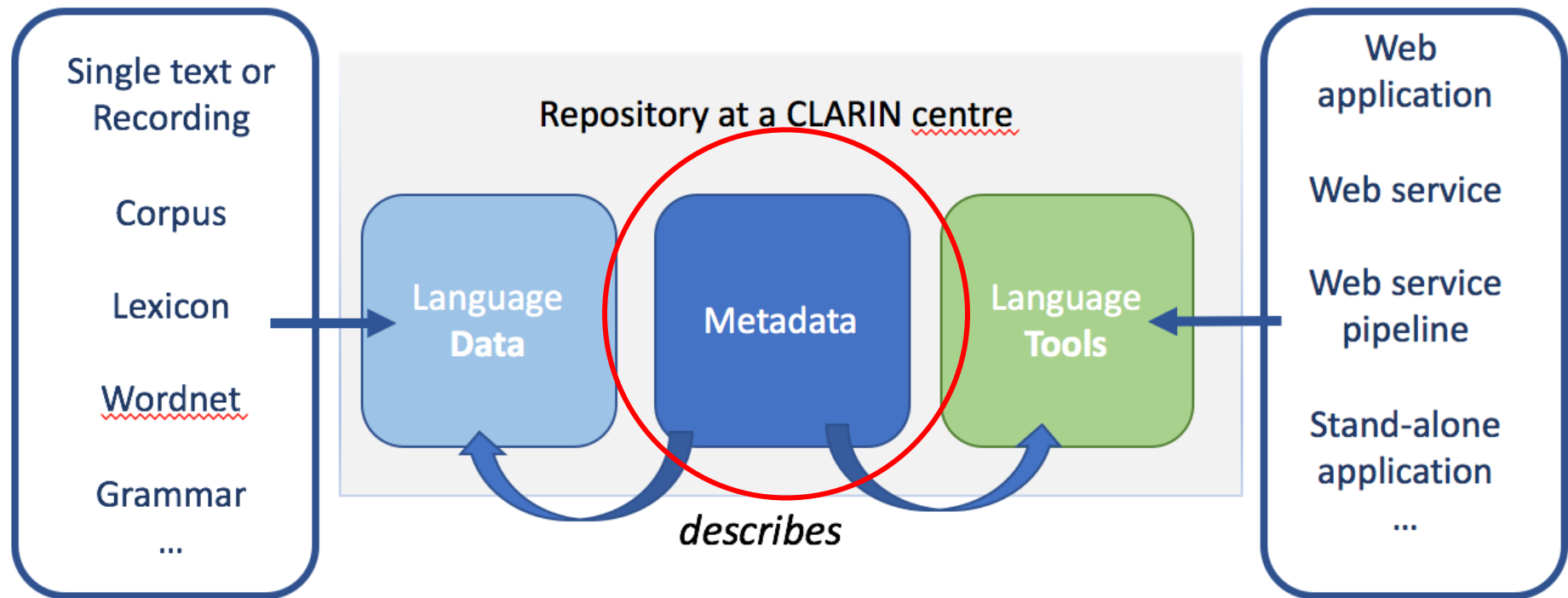

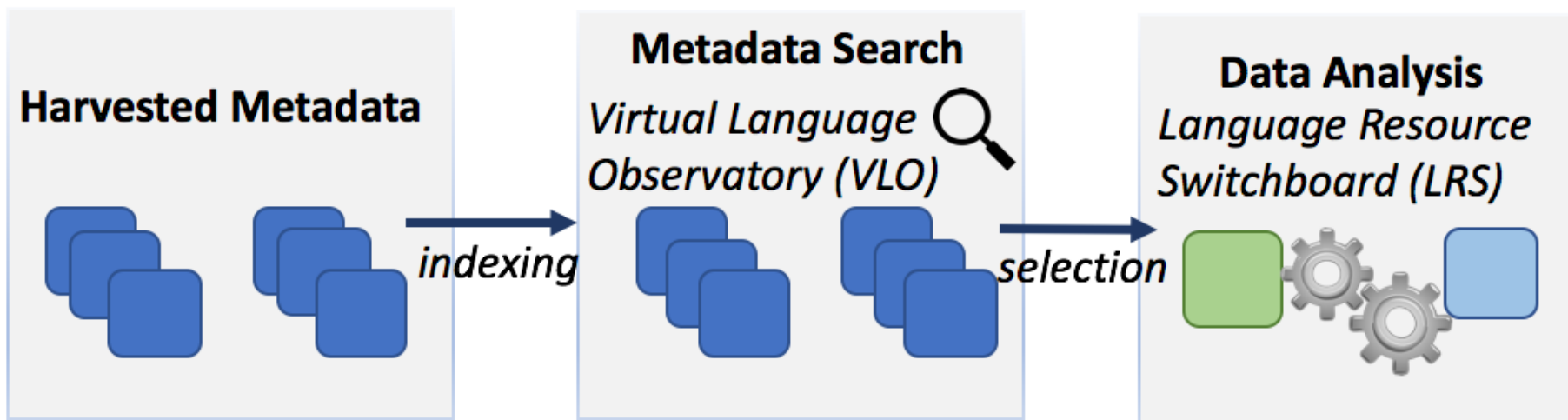

The CLARIN data architecture: *central processing of metadata*



In the design of CLARIN interoperability is key

- to enable the exchange and harvesting of metadata
- to identify suitable exchange formats for the output of analytic tools for language data
- to the options for supporting comparative research;

[ParlaMint](#), a CLARIN initiative aimed at interoperability of parliamentary data and public debate on COVID-19; data in around 20 languages, including Spanish



CLARIN and Open Science

- Promoting the sharing and re-use of data through sustainable data registries
 - Academia, Industry, Citizen Science, GLAM sector
- All integrated datasets available in open access for research purposes
- Adherence to the FAIR data principles
 - Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Re-usable
 - Interoperability through a common metadata framework
- Support for linguistic diversity
 - Data covering more than 1500 languages
 - Tools for many languages
 - Language resources in all modalities
- Strengthening the support for > 500.000 professional SSH researchers in Europe and globally a multitude.



CLARIN as ecosystem for knowledge exchange

- A network of Knowledge Centres (K-centres)
- Sharing of expertise and best practices
 - Annual Conference
 - Support for workshops and mobility
 - Ambassador network
- Capacity training through life events, online courses and webinars
 - for developers
 - for end-users
- Collaboration with
 - other SSH infrastructures (e.g. CESSDA, DARIAH-EU, ESS, SHARE;
 - Europeana, LIBER, EASSH, ADHO, Time Machine, ...
- Membership of EOSC (=European Open Science Cloud)
 - projects: EOSC-hub, EOSC Future, FAIRCORE4EOSC, EOSC Focus;
 - participation in EOSC task forces
